FAIR SHARE DONATIONS

The music program is a self-funded program. In order to run a high quality program, at the beginning of every year we ask for a small donation. This voluntary donation takes the place of extra fundraising. This fair share donation will cover the cost of music, books, festivals, transportation, rewards and activities. It does not cover the cost of participation in optional field trips.

The suggested fair share donation for each family is \$50. Every dollar goes directly to the music program. The other main fundraiser for our music program is tickets sales at our concerts. Families who donate \$100 or more to the Fair Share Donation campaign will receive family passes to our concerts. Concert tickets are \$5 per person.

CONCERT DRESS

To show pride in our performances and respect for our audience, please wear the following for all performances:

Gentlemen – Black dress slacks (not jeans), white dress shirt (tucked in) with black necktie, black dress shoes and <u>black socks</u>

Ladies – Concert black (dressy black pants, skirt with a nice black top or a black dress). Skirts and dresses should be ankle length. Short skirts and sleeveless tops are inappropriate for concert wear. This is to create a uniform look, but also to protect modesty. Please note that at certain performance venues the audience is at eye level with the stage.

MATERIALS

It is suggested that students bring the following supplies to class each day in order to be successful:

1. Instrument in good playing condition and supplies:

<u>Strings</u>

Rosin, Dust cloth, Shoulder rest or end pin rest, tuner/Snark (optional—but highly recommended)

Woodwinds

<u>At least **3 good reeds** at all times</u> (Strengths of 2.5 or above), cork grease, Cleaning swab (rod and cloth for flutes)

<u>Brass</u>

Valve oil (slide oil for trombones & rotor oil for French horn) & slide grease

<u>Percussion</u> (the stick bag with sticks/mallets needs to come to class):

- 1. Drum pad & bell kit or piano at home for practice
- Stick bag that includes: Please label all equipment and bags Drum sticks - Vic Firth standard concert sticks Xylophone/bell mallets - hard rubber Timpani mallets - labeled "General"

2. Name Tag

Make sure instruments have some sort of name tag. Many cases look the same and an identifiable name tag helps to protect your investment. Include name, phone number, and Rancho Pico Junior High School.

3. Binder

It is HIGHLY recommended that students get a binder for band to protect their music.

- 1" binder (preferably a dark color)
- 5 Dividers
- Place for a couple of pencils

4. Pencil

Students should have a pencil on his/her music stand during class everyday.

5. Music Stand (for home practice)

If you do not have access to any of the suggested items listed above, please contact Mrs. Stoffel and supplies will be provided for use during class.

INSTRUMENT STORAGE

Students may drop off their instruments in the band & orchestra room before school. The room is kept secure throughout the day and is NEVER left unlocked. MAKE SURE YOUR INSTRUMENT HAS A NAME TAG!

CLASSROOM POLICIES

These policies are designed to create a sense of community and insure student success.

Be Polite and Respectful: Students will treat themselves and others around them with respect. Students will respect the directions of the teacher. Students will respect instruments and equipment. In short, students will behave like ladies and gentlemen.

Be Responsible: Students will take responsibility for their actions regarding behavior and grades. Students need to bring materials and assignments to each class and concert.

No food/gum/devices. Food and gum can be detrimental to equipment. Water bottles are allowed. Devices are an unnecessary distraction. Students have ample device time outside of class.

GRADING & PRACTICE

Students earn their grades. You must keep up with assignments (including practice charts!). Students should practice 4-5 days per week. Grades will be based on the following:

40% Daily Participation

Students earn points for bringing materials and being attentive in class.

40% Playing Tests/Practice Charts/Written Assignments

Students will turn in weekly practice charts and play 5-8 playing tests per quarter during class time. Quality of practice is more valuable than quantity.

20% Performances

Concert performances are <u>required</u>. (please check calendar on front page)

GRADING SCALE

Grades will be determined by the percentage of possible points earned:

- A 90-100%
- B 80-89%
- C 70-79%
- D 60-69%
- F below 60%
